Access and shuttle service: (Military Wives Choir at Harrow School)

There is ample car parking available on Garlands Lane, just off Peterborough Road on Harrow Hill. For those who might find the walk up Harrow Hill difficult, St Luke's volunteers will provide a shuttle service from the Garlands Lane car park to the venue from 6.30pm on the night until the last guests have returned to their cars. Access to the Speech Room is via a series of ramps through the War Memorial Building. There is one step, from the pavement to the War Memorial, which isn't ramped. There are two wheelchair spaces. Unfortunately mobility scooters cannot be accommodated.

Saturday 1st July

The Little Big Band at Arc House HA1 3GR from 7pm

Enjoy a picnic in the park at the Arc performance space and amphitheatre in Lowlands Park next to Harrow-on-the Hill station. Bring your own picnic or buy delicious food and hot drinks from the Arc café. A bar will also be open throughout the evening while you are entertained with music from The Little Big Band. The jazz band has performed in many public venues and at professional gigs since it was started by older pupils at Whitmore High School in 2014.

Seating in the openair amphitheatre is only £10. Some seats are available under cover [see booking form].



Thursday 6th July - Opera in The Great Barn, HA2 6PX

Doors open at 7pm, performance begins at 7.30pm
Running time approximately 2 hours plus interval.

After our sellout opera evening in the Granary in 2016, we are delighted to present a full opera in the much larger sixteenth century Tithe Barn in the grounds of the medieval moated Headstone Manor.

Il matrimonio segreto is an 18th century Italian comic opera with the influence of Mozart in the music. Filled with comic intrigues and confusions, the story is about following your heart and makes a perfect summer opera filled with the special Pop-up Opera humour, sparkle and fun .Pop-up Opera is an innovative touring opera company dedicated to making opera enjoyable and inviting without losing the quality of the musical performance.



You will be welcomed with a non-alcoholic cocktail and the ticket price includes finger food. Wine, spirits and beer are available from the bar run by The Great Barn, and a donation of £2 will be made to the hospice for each glass of wine sold.

Doors open at 7pm, concert begins at 7.30pm Violinist Adrian Butterfield leads his Baroque String Quartet, The London Handel Players, in a concert including masterpieces by Handel, Bach and Telemann and their illustrious contemporaries. Handel composed his Chandos Anthems for the iconic church of St Lawrence three hundred years ago. Drinks available in the church hall before the performance and during the interval.



Saturday 8th July - Military Wives Choir

In the famous Speech Room at Harrow School HA1 3HP

Doors open at 7pm for guests to enjoy drinks on the terrace with views over Harrow, in the beautiful War Memorial Building and upstairs in the historic Old Harrovian Room. The music will start at 8pm, a concert of classics and the latest repertoire of the North London Military Wives Choir, founded to bring women in the military community closer together through singing following the success of Gareth Malone's TV programme and recording in 2011. Their latest performances have included Stronger Together, Bring Him Home, Rule the World, Make You Feel My Love, Annie's Song and a Vera Lynn medley. There will be an interval and an opportunity for the audience to sing too.
